## Location

The Outdoor Education Center of the Battle Creek Public Schools is located near Dowling, Michigan, between Battle Creek and Hastings on M-37. This large woodland setting on the shore of Clear Lake offers hiking, nature observation and canoeing. The main lodge contains two wooden dance floors and dining area. Lodging is provided in two bunkhouses. Each has two sets of hot showers and bunk beds in separate rooms for men, women, and couples. Tent and RV sites are available. However, the BCOEC prohibits electrical hookups.

## Work Scholarships

Work scholarships are available; applications must be submitted by 28 Feb. Priority is based on financial need and experience. For an application, check the appropriate box on the registration form.

## A Residential Camp is a Great Value
